These materials will be scanned and included in the information provided to our members at our annual meeting. Your completed form and any supplemental materials must be returned to me no later than April 1, 2012. This is a great opportunity to showcase your talents to our member guilds!

The next MAQNet meeting will be Saturday, April 21, 2012, from 10 a.m. until 3 pm. Details to follow in the near future. You are welcome to attend. There will be a fee of \$10 to cover costs.
